Major Requirements: 35 semester hours, exclusive of WL101 and WL102. **At least 18 semester hours must be taken at Aquinas.** A maximum of 16 semester hours may be applied to the major through Advanced Placement, Credit by Exam, and Life Experience. All majors are required to spend a semester abroad or complete an approved internship either in the United States or abroad. A cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above must be maintained in major courses. Only courses with a grade of C or better will count toward the major.
