How much are the grants worth?

We will be awarding three \$500 grants.

Who is eligible to apply?

All K-12 educators (school counselors, administrators and teachers) employed by accredited schools and who are graduates of Aquinas College. Grants are open to educators in private, public or charter schools.

How do I apply?

Applicants should complete the attached form in full. Please include THREE (3) copies of your application.

How will winners be selected?

Proposals will be evaluated by members of the Aquinas College Alumni Association and the dean of the School of Education. Awards will be based on the following criteria:

- Number of students involved
- Project's potential to improve student curiosity and love of learning
- Project's potential to make a lasting impact, such as replicating the project for broader use
- Project's cost-effectiveness
- Project being student-centered
- Project supports curriculum
- Project has measurable outcomes
- Project complements values and mission of Aquinas College

When will winners be announced?

Grants will be announced in December 2011. Funds will be distributed by Christmas break.

What happens when the project ends?

Each grantee is required to submit a final report detailing project costs and a brief summary of project outcome. If your project costs are significantly less than you anticipated, any unused funds should be returned to your school district.

Any equipment purchased for the project becomes the property of the school district. If for some reason, your project is never implemented, funds should be returned to the alumni association so that another grant can be awarded.
