

### Criteria for Athletic Hall of Fame Membership-Athlete

- An athlete becomes eligible for nomination to the Hall of Fame five years after graduation or leaving the College.
- An athlete must have earned at least two letters in one sport, one letter in two or more sports, or brought recognition to the College by his or her athletic endeavors.
- An outstanding career as an athlete must be continued by an exemplary career in the individual's profession or occupation, a record which reflects credit to the person and the College.
- A candidate must receive a minimum affirmative vote of 75% of the members of the Board.

### Criteria for Athletic Hall of Fame Membership-Athletic Staff or Faculty

- A member of the staff or faculty becomes eligible for nomination after serving at least five years at the College.
- A member of the staff or faculty must have served the College for a minimum of five years.
- An outstanding career as a faculty or staff member must be evident and must have had a direct and significant impact on athletics at the College.
- A candidate must receive a minimum affirmation vote of 75% of the members of the Board.
