Student Password Retrieval Process

Students registering for the first time since summer 2004, who have never received a One-

January 8, 2007

Time Access Key, will receive an informational letter that will contain:

- their One-Time Access Key
- instructions for retrieving their temporary passwords

To retrieve their temporary passwords online, students will need:

- their One-Time Access Key
- their Student ID Number
- their Social Security Number

Students may pick up their One-Time Access Key and instructions for retrieving their passwords by taking a picture ID (student ID or driver's license) to Campus Safety, ITS, or

Woodhouse Library. Campus Safety is open twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week.

Students will retrieve two passwords:

- **Ironwood** (Novell) password for logging in to computers in the labs
- **Elm** password for access to Mailbox, The Moose, Calendar, CourseConnect, MyAQ, and ResNet

Students are asked to change both passwords the first time they log in.

Student Email Forwarding

1. To have all mail automatically forwarded from your **student** Aquinas email account to another email address, follow these steps: Go to <http://www.aquinas.edu/elm> from any web browser.
2. Click on the "wrench" icon to access Account Maintenance.
3. If you are not already signed on, enter your username and password and then click "Login."
4. Click on the "Forward Mail" link.

5. Type the email address you would like your mail forwarded to in the text box.
6. If you would like a copy of your messages stored on your Aquinas email account, leave "Deliver mail to my local account" checked. *Note: if you choose this option, you should log into MailBox occasionally and delete unneeded messages to prevent your Inbox from becoming full.*
7. Click "Make Changes" and your email will be set up for automatic forwarding. For documentation with graphics, please visit:
