

## JANE HIBBARD IDEMA WOMEN'S STUDIES CENTER EVENT

The Jane Hibbard Idema Women's Studies Center will host **Barbara Homrich, Ph. D.** for a discussion entitled **"Eating Disorders: A Crisis in Eating and Weight"** from **12:30 to 1:30 p.m. on Tuesday, Oct. 9 in the Loutit Room of the Wege Center.** Homrich is a clinical psychologist and substance abuse program director for Claystone Clinical Associates, and maintains special interest and expertise in eating disorders. The event is free and open to the public.

According to Homrich, eating disorders are especially prevalent on college campuses, where psychological, interpersonal, social and biological factors all play a role in their formation. "Once started, they can create a self-perpetuating cycle of physical and emotional destruction," said Homrich. Common eating disorders include Anorexia Nervosa and Bulimia Nervosa. While eating disorders are seen in both men and women, Homrich notes that "studies suggest that between 60 and 80 percent of college women regularly engage in binge eating or other abnormal eating behaviors that often fall just below the clinical criteria for an eating disorder." In her lecture, Homrich will address types of eating disorders, their development and the treatment necessary for recovery. "Anorexia has the highest mortality rate of any psychiatric disorder," said Homrich. "Professional help is necessary for the treatment of eating disorders."

Barbara Homrich counsels patients at Claystone Clinical Associates in Grand Rapids, Michigan, where she is certified as a Limited Licensed Psychologist, a Licensed Professional Counselor and a Certified Addictions Counselor.
