- Makes eye contact with infants and toddlers and teachers.
  
- Engages in and initiates appropriate activities with infants and toddlers.
  
- Uses positive redirection and "some" natural consequences for behavior management.
  
- Uses proper tone of voice and appropriate physical contact with infants and toddlers
