



Class Absences/Medical Excuse Policy

Students who are not feeling well are required to contact their professors regarding class absence, missed work, and make up work.

The Aquinas College Health Center does not issue "notes" for classes missed. When a student is advised by the Health Center to stay out of class due to sickness or injury, the health Center will contact Advising for an e-mail to be sent to the professors of classes the student will not be attending for that day.

Appointment cards given to students should not be used by students or accepted by faculty as documentation for a class absence.

With the student's permission, the Health Center will verify if the student was seen at the Health Center on a specific date; however, we will not discuss the reason for the visit.
