### **General Program Information**

- LOCATION:** St. Thomas Aquinas College in Sparkill, New York. Sparkill is a short commute from New York City. The College was founded by the Dominican sisters, and has approximately 2,200 students.
- DURATION:** **One semester; either fall or spring** (If applying to a fall semester program the application must be submitted by **February 1** of the preceding academic year. If applying to a spring semester program, the application must be submitted by **September 1**.)
- ELIGIBILITY:** **Full-time students, at least sophomore status must have a minimum cumulative grade point average in all subjects of 3.00.**
- HOUSING:** **Students stay in university dormitories.**

- FACULTY:** **Students are taught by St. Thomas Aquinas College instructors.**
