LOCATION: The Center International d'Études Françaises (CIDEF) at the Université Catholique de l'Ouest in Angers, France.

DURATION: Program will coincide roughly with Spring Semester (February-June).

ELIGIBILITY: Students must be full-time students of at least sophomore status, have completed FH 201 or its test equivalent, have an openness to cross-cultural experiences and living with French families, and not be on academic or discipline-related probation.

HOUSING: Students stay in homes with French families.

ACADEMICS: Upon arrival, students will take a placement exam. Students will participate in classes focused on French language and civilization. Additional electives may be offered in the following fields: Translation, Art, History, Theater, Music, Philosophy, Literature, Economics, etc.

COST: Aquinas Spring Semester Full-Time Tuition + \$5900
Estimated Program Fee (Program Fees will be confirmed on acceptance letters)
Program fee includes:

- Housing for duration of program
- Academic materials and excursions through CIDEF
- Round-Trip airfare from Grand Rapids
- Int'l Student ID with medical and travel insurance

OTHER COSTS: Board, passport and visa; personal spending on gifts, food, travel, etc.; postage.
