## ***Tübingen*** ***Germany***

**LOCATION:** Tübingen, Germany

**DURATION:** Program coincides with the German academic calendar: approximate dates April through July

**ELIGIBILITY:** Full-time students, at least sophomore status, completion of GN 201 or its test equivalent, openness to cross-cultural experience, not on academic or discipline-related probation

**HOUSING:** University dormitories in Tübingen

**ACADEMICS:** Students will enroll in a minimum of 17 credit hours consisting of the first half of GN202 taken at Aquinas during third quad and the credits taken in Tübingen

***Required Courses:***

German language (grammar)  
German language (reading, writing, conversation)  
German Culture & Civilization

***Electives: (3 credits)***

Prep Course for the Zeitstudenten Exam  
*\*Language proficiency test for international students wishing to matriculate to a German university*

**FACULTY:** Courses are taught by University of Tübingen instructors

**COST:** Aquinas Spring Semester Full-Time Tuition + Estimated Program fee of \$4800 (Program Fees will be confirmed in acceptance letters).
