- LOCATION:** Tübingen, Germany
- DURATION:** Program coincides with the German academic calendar: approximate dates April through July
- ELIGIBILITY:** Full-time students, at least sophomore status, completion of GN 201 or its test equivalent, openness to cross-cultural experience, not on academic or discipline-related probation
- HOUSING:** University dormitories in Tübingen
- ACADEMICS:** Students will enroll in a minimum of 17 credit hours consisting of the first half of GN202 taken at Aquinas during third quad and the credits taken in Tübingen
- Required Courses:*  
German language (grammar)  
German language (reading, writing, conversation)  
German Culture & Civilization
- Electives: (3 credits)*  
Prep Course for the Zeitstudenten Exam  
*\*Language proficiency test for international students wishing to matriculate to a German university*
- FACULTY:** Courses are taught by University of Tübingen instructors
- COST:** Aquinas Spring Semester Full-Time Tuition + Estimated Program fee of \$5000 (Program Fees will be confirmed in acceptance letters).
