## *Ireland*

- LOCATION:** Tully Cross is a small rural village in the Connemara region of County Galway which is located on the western coast of Ireland.
- Duration:** Program will coincide roughly with Spring Semester
- STUDY CENTER:** Students live in thatched-roof cottages with central heating, electricity, cooking facilities, a washer and a dryer.
- ELIGIBILITY:** Students must be traditional, full-time students of at least sophomore status who are willing to share in community living and be open to cross-cultural experience, and in good academic and disciplinary standing.
- ACADEMICS:** There are three required courses: Values Seminar: Experiencing Ireland, Irish Literary Heritage, Irish History. Elective courses will also be offered, including the Teachers' Aides in National Schools.
- GROUP TRAVEL:** Three or four group excursions.
- MID-SEMESTER BREAK:** Approximately two weeks give students the opportunity for personal travel.
- COST:** Aquinas College semester tuition + Estimated Program Fee of \$5400 (Includes housing, airfare, International Student ID Card, and group excursions) Program fees will be confirmed on acceptance letters.
- OTHER COSTS:** Passport (approximately \$97), food, Eurail or BritRail passes, money for gifts, personal travel during breaks.
- 2011 FACULTY:** Professor Jennifer Dawson (English Department) and Professor Jason Duncan (History Department)
