

## MLA Style Citations of Electronic and Multimedia Sources

**Please note:** Titles of works can be underlined or printed in *italics* as shown.

### Web Pages and Web Sites:

**Format:**

Author's name (if given). "*Title of the Web Page.*" *Title of the Web Site* (if distinct from Web page). Version or edition used (if available). Publisher or sponsor the site (or N.p. if not available), Date of publication (if not available, use n.d.). Medium of publication (Web). Date of access.

**Example:**

Quade, Alex. "Elite Team Rescues Troops behind Enemy Lines." CNN.com. Cable News Network,  
26 Oct. 2007. Web. 29 Oct. 2007.

### Full-text article from online database

**Format:**

Author's name (if given). "Title of the Article." *Name of the Journal* volume number.issue number (year): Pages.  
*Name of Database*. Medium of publication consulted (Web). Date of access.

**Example:**

Chan, Evan. "Postmodernism and Hong Kong Cinema." *Postmodern Culture* 10.3 (2000): n. pag. *Project Muse*.  
Web. 20 May 2002.

### Article in online scholarly publication:

**Format:**

Author's name. "Title of the Article." *Name of the Magazine* Volume.Issue (Year of publication): pages. Medium  
of publication (Web). Date of access.

**Example:**

Armstrong, Grace. "Images of Virtue: Reading, Reformation and the Visualization of Culture." *Bryn Mawr  
Review of Comparative Literature* 6.1 (2007): n. pag. Web. 8 Nov. 2007.

### Online Newspaper Article:

**Format:**

Author's name (if given). "Title of the Article." *Name of Newspaper*. Publisher of Site, Date of publication.

Medium of publication (Web). Date of access.

**Example:**

"The Scientists Speak." Editorial. *New York Times*. New York Times, 20 Nov. 2007. Web. 20 Nov. 2007.

**Online Encyclopedia:****Format:**

Author's name (if given). "Article title." *Title of Online Encyclopedia*. Editor's name (if available). Publisher. Year of Publication. Medium of publication (Web). Date of access.

**Example:**

"Albert Einstein." *Encyclopedia Britannica Online*. Encyclopedia Britannica. 2007. Web. 19 Mar. 2008.

**E-mail:****Format:**

Sender's name. "Title of message (taken from subject line)" Description of the message that includes the recipient and/or discussion group. Date of message. Medium of delivery.

**Example:**

Buczowski, Chad. "Re: Events Committee Projects." E-mail to Christina Radisauskas. 15 June 2008. E-mail.

**Television or Radio Broadcast:****Format:**

"Title of episode or segment (if appropriate)." *Title of program or series*. Name of network (if any). Call letters and city of station (if any). Broadcast date. Medium of reception.

**Example:**

"Frederick Douglass." *Civil War Journal*. Narr. Danny Glover. Dir. Craig Haffner. Arts and Entertainment Network. 2 Apr. 1993. Television.

**Film or Video Recording****Format:**

*Title*. Director. Distributor. Year of release. Medium.

*Note:* Other data such as names of screenwriters, performers, etc may be added between the title and the distributor. For films dubbed or subtitled in English, you may give the English title and follow it with the original title enclosed in brackets.

**Example:**

"*Like Water for Chocolate* [*Como agua para chocolate*]." Screenplay by Laura Esquivel. Dir. Alfonso Arau. Perf. Lumi Cavazos, Marco Lombardi, and Regina Torne. Miramax, 1993. Film.
