CONTEST INFORMATION and RULES AND REGULATIONS

ROUNDS OF COMPETITION

There will be three rounds of competition. The first round will take place on Tuesday, February 1, 2011 at 10:30 p.m. in The Moose Café. The second round will take place on Tuesday, February 8, 2011 at 10:30 p.m. in The Moose Café. Contestants must check-in at 10:00 p.m. in the Campus Life Office. The final round of competition will take place on Friday, February 18 during the "Wake Up People!" Party. Time of final performance is still to be determined.

CONTESTANTS

The first round of competition will be limited to 15 contestants. The second round of competition will be made up of a maximum of 6 contestants from the first round of 15 contestants. Only one-person acts may apply- no groups, bands, etc.

PERFORMANCES

Contestants must present their vocal talent in a 4 minute or less format or they will be disqualified from the competition. No "banned" words may be sung/spoken that cannot be used on the radio. If the radio bleeps it, you bleep it, too! Those who are selected as second round finalists are required to sing a different song than what they performed in the first round. For the final round, finalists will be asked to perform two songs of their choice and one "judges choice" song.

ACCOMPANIMENT

Contestants must perform with a background track or accompany themselves on an instrument- no "a capella" performances, and no guest accompanists. (Often background tracks may be purchased and downloaded from iTunes by searching the song name and/or "karaoke", or from websites such as http://www.stingray-music.com/consumer_products_audio.html if you do not own the music you would like to perform.) *All contestants must bring to check-in a CD with their performance song CLEARLY marked with their name and ONLY the track that they are performing with may be on the disc.*

CONTESTANT CONDUCT

AQ Idol and Wake Up People are substance-free events. Any contestant who has used alcohol and/or drugs prior to, or during, the competition(s) will be automatically disqualified. All contestants will sign conduct agreements before performing.

JUDGES

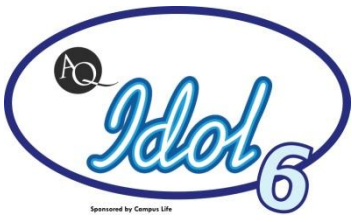
The judging panel will be made up of a qualified, un-biased variety of individuals with training and background in music and entertainment. The decision of the judges will be final.
