

1. What if my Aquinas student is an only child?

Jr. Saints Weekend is designed to end the celebration of St. Thomas Aquinas Week and provide family and friends the opportunity to get together with some fun activities at Aquinas. Anyone ages 6 and up are invited!

2. How do I register? What does it cost?

All participants must be registered and will receive a wristband for the activities. The Aquinas College student must also be a registered participant but will not incur a registration fee. The first guest can register for \$10.00. Each additional guest is \$5. The fee is used to offset snacks and various programs that are offered throughout the weekend.

We ask that all guests are registered by **Friday, January 20, 2012**. This allows us a week to prepare for your arrival.

3. What happens if we need to cancel our participation?

We know that "things happen" and there may be a chance you won't be able to join us. Unfortunately, we are not able to provide a full refund for your cancellation. We have to be able to cover our expenses for the entire program. We are able to provide a 50% refund if a request in writing is provided by noon on Friday, January 27. Please note that we will begin to process those reimbursements the Monday following the program.

Students/Families who are "no shows" after registering will forfeit their entire registration and are ineligible for a partial refund.

4. Where do Jr. Saints participants stay while they are visiting Aquinas?

Residents who are having a guest for the weekend can have their guest stay with them in the residential communities unless they are 12 and older and a different gender. If that is the case, those participants will need to stay in a room with a resident of the same gender.

Commuter Students will have access to Regina lobby and the Cook Carriage House between activities. If your ID does not already offer you access to Regina, please contact Campus Safety for assistance.

5. What do the participants need to bring for the weekend?

- Winter outdoor clothing
- Sleeping Bag and Sleepover Gear for the weekend
- BIG SMILE for your picture with our mascot, Nelson ☺
- Black shirt for the Black Out Basketball Games or Aquinas College apparel (Saints' Squad preferred!)
- Few extra dollars for the off campus activities available
- A towel for the swimming pool! Please note that private locker rooms are provided.

6. Who is responsible for the participants?

Each Aquinas student is responsible for their guests and will be held accountable for their actions and the actions of their guests on or off campus. It is also the responsibility of the Aquinas student to accompany their guest to all activities and throughout the residence halls. If a participant is found unaccompanied their

emergency contact person will be notified. Students are encouraged to review the Student Handbook with regard to regulations for your guests.

7. How are emergencies handled?

All emergencies are handled by Campus Safety and/or the Residence Life staff. Upon registration emergency contact and health information is gathered to further assist emergency staff on how to appropriately deal with a certain participant. Please provide current information on the registration form.

8. How do participants eat while attending Jr. Saints' Weekend?

Student, faculty, or staff members who have a meal plan or meal money on their ID's can use meal swipes or meal money for their guest. Local vendors have specific AQ rates and specials. These will be highlighted in your check-in information.

9. What if a participant has special needs for the weekend, how are they accommodated?

If your guest requires special accommodations in order to be a full participant in the program, please indicate those needs on the registration form.

10. When and where do we check in for the weekend?

On Friday January 27, 2012 check in (and on-site registration) will be at Cook Carriage House . The packets will be available at 4pm. Jr. Saints' staff will be on hand the entire evening to offer materials for those checking in throughout the night.
