Major Requirements: 78 semester hours. **At least 30 semester hours in Studio Art and 9 semester hours in Art History must be taken at Aquinas. At least 9 semester hours of Studio Art must be earned during the last two years prior to graduation.** Entry into the BFA major is via a portfolio review. The portfolio is reviewed every semester. A senior portfolio must be submitted before mid-term of the final semester. BFA majors are required to do a final thesis exhibition. Only courses with a grade of C- or better will count toward the major.
