CAMPUS CRIME ALERT BULLETIN

In compliance with the "Timely Notice" provisions of the federal Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1998, the Department of Campus Safety is providing the campus community with notice of the following:

Grand Rapids Police and several area neighborhood associations have issued an alert after at least two break-ins and attempted sexual assaults in the past few days.

The first happened on the night of Tuesday March 17th in the 200 block of Diamond Ave. SE where a woman told police a man came into her home and attempted to sexually assault her.

The second incident occurred during the morning hours of Thursday March 19th in the 300 block of Eastern Ave. SE. There, a woman says a man entered her home and also attempted to sexually assault her, but the man was scared off by others in the home.

Grand Rapids Police are still trying to figure out if the two crimes were committed by the same person. Anyone with information is asked to call police or Silent Observer at (616) 774-2345.
