CAMPUS CRIME ALERT BULLETIN

In compliance with the "Timely Notice" provisions of the federal Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1998, the Department of Campus Safety is providing the campus community with notice of the following:

The Eastown Community Association reports that recently the north side of Eastown has been experiencing auto larcenies. In the past two weeks two laptops have been stolen along with other expensive personal items from automobiles. These larcenies have occurred in the 300 Block of Richard Terrace and the 300 Block of Benjamin.

Remember to lock your cars and keep valuables out of plain sight.

Be mindful of your environment and report any suspicious activity to the GRPD at 456.3400 (non-emergency) or by calling 911.

Additionally, if you fall victim to a larceny or other criminal act - REPORT IT TO THE POLICE. Records of these incidents must be kept so that criminal activity may be tracked and similarities in the incidents can be noted. Having this information may help to prosecute individuals in the future.
