



- Ada Business Association Scholarship -

AWARD POLICY

Aquinas College is pleased to partner with the Ada Business Association (ABA) to offer tuition scholarships for eligible employees of existing member organizations who are in good standing. This scholarship can be combined with any tuition reimbursement an organization may provide.

Scholarship amount:	It provides a 20% tuition scholarship.
Number of credit hours:	There is currently no limit on the number of credit hours for which it may be used. The scholarship amount is the same whether one attends part time or full time.
Length of scholarship:	Once received, it is available for seven years or until graduation, whichever occurs sooner.*
Degree/non-degree seeking:	Some may choose to earn a full degree while others may be non-degree seeking and enroll in a few classes for personal or professional enrichment.
Applicable programs:	Both undergraduate and graduate courses in the following programs are eligible: <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Continuing Education (The undergraduate program for adults approximately 23 or over, offering both associate and bachelor degrees.)▪ Master of Management▪ Master of Arts in Clinical Mental Health Counseling▪ Master in Education with Initial Secondary Certification▪ Master in the Art of Teaching
Additional Scholarships:	This scholarship can be combined with privately-funded scholarships; however, it may not be used in conjunction with others, such as the Hruby Scholarship and the Donnelly Scholarship. Visit aquinas.edu/financial-aid for information.
When to enroll:	In general, new classes begin roughly every eight weeks. One may choose to begin classes in August, October, January, March, May or June.
