The Aquinas College Ireland Program is located in Tully Cross— a small rural village in the Connemara region of County Galway which is located on the western coast of Ireland. - GPA of 2.5+
- Must be at least a rising Sophomore status (not based on credits)
- In good academic and disciplinary standing
