

Ferris State University College of Pharmacy - Fact Sheet

Ferris State University College of Pharmacy (FSU-COP) and Aquinas College agree to establish a cooperative program of pre-pharmacy education by which pre-pharmacy students at Aquinas College shall be granted an early assurance of admission to FSU-COP through the Early Assurance Program.

The Early Assurance Program provides an enhanced opportunity for admission to pharmacy school to Aquinas College students. By identifying and developing these students, Aquinas College will make a substantial contribution to the pharmacy work force of the future and enhance the Aquinas College's presence as a partner in the west Michigan health care community.

Fees:

Only the common application (PharmCAS) will be charged.

Requirements:

The Ferris State University College of Pharmacy is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education to offer the Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.) program.

Required Pre-pharmacy Course Work with a minimum of C grade or better.
