A 2.0 overall GPA is required to declare and maintain the major. Only courses with a grade of C or better will count toward the major. Students may take a course twice to obtain the requisite C grade SC=Senior Capstone. WI-Writing Intensive. All CN courses qualify for General Education Social Science: Group 1 and Group 2 distribution. Students seeking a Speech Major-Secondary Education are encouraged to pursue this major if not pursuing Communication w/Theatre emphasis.
