Major Requirements: 81 semester hours. At least 24 semester hours must be taken at Aquinas, 18 of which must be taken in Accounting courses at the 300 level and above. Total hours for the degree must be at least 150. A minimum of 150 hours are required to be a CPA in Michigan. A GPA of at least 2.0 must be maintained. Only courses with a grade of C- or better will count toward the major. Students may take a course twice to obtain the requisite C-.
