Students are strongly encouraged to complete an Internship. A GPA of 2.0 must be maintained. Only courses with a grade of C or better will count toward the minor. Students may take a course twice to obtain the requisite C grade. SC=Senior Capstone. WI=Writing Intensive. All CN courses qualify for General Education Social Science: Group 1 and 2 Distribution
