- CN 299 - Communications inside & outside the Church (3)

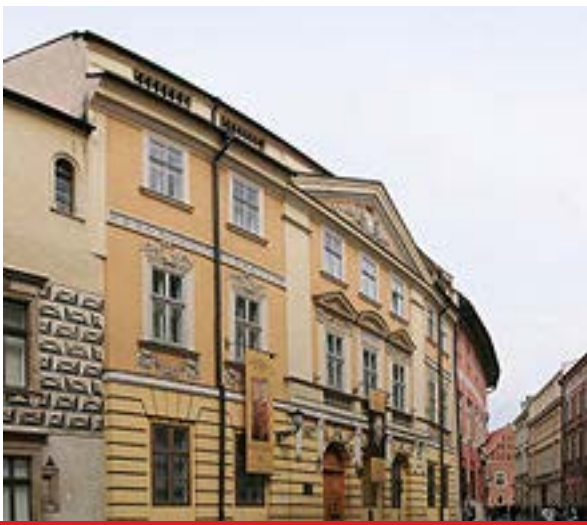


ELIGIBILITY
