WELCOME TO SPRING, 2020!

SPRING REGISTRATION INFORMATION

To be eligible to register, you must first meet with your advisor to review your academic plan, unless you are a CE student. CE students are encouraged to meet with their academic advisors, but are not required to have advisor permission to register. After this meeting, your advisor will release the advisor hold and electronically give you permission to register for Spring, 2020. Without this permission, you will be unable to register. Advising for Spring, 2020 starts on Tuesday, October 22, 2019.

As of October 21, 2019, there will be no further advisor changes until after December 9, 2019.

The first date for registration is based on current class level for traditional-age students. Insignis students may register one day before the rest of their class. CE students may register with the Senior class. PLEASE NOTE: Registration via MyAQ will begin at MIDNIGHT on the dates listed.

Online Registration Instructions:

- Login to MyAQ through your ELM menu. Select "**Students**" from the menu.
- Start by selecting your classes using "**Search/Register for Sections.**"
 - ✓ Select **Term** at the top of the page (e.g. Spring Semester 2020).
 - ✓ At a minimum, select the **Subject** of the course you would like to take. For example, if the course is CN 101, select Communication.
 - ✓ If you know the exact course number enter it now, (e.g. 101) under **Course Number**.
 - ✓ Click on **[SUBMIT]**.
- You will now be on a page entitled "**Section Selection Results**".
 - ✓ Select one or more courses by clicking on the box to the left of each course you'd like to take.
 - ✓ When you have selected all of the courses for this subject, click on **[SUBMIT]**.
 - ✓ To select additional classes, click on the back arrow key and repeat the **Search/Register for Sections** process as necessary.
- You will now move to the "**Register and Drop Sections**" page on which you will actually register for your classes. Once a class is listed on this page, it has been saved, and will not be removed unless you purposefully remove it. However, you have still not registered for the course yet.
 - ✓ To register for one or more of your classes at a time, select **Register** from the pull-down menu next to EACH course (underneath the column entitled, **Action**).
 - ✓ Check the bottom of the screen to be sure that the selection for the question:
 - **If one of my choices is not available= PART Complete only available.**This will ensure that if one class has an error, you can still register for your other classes.
 - ✓ Click on **[SUBMIT]** to register only for the classes you have selected.

General Information

- You will not be able to register if you have any holds on your account. To check if you have any holds, select **“Registration Holds”** in MyAQ. If nothing is listed on the page, you have no holds.
- If you need instructor permission to take a class, you'll need to bring a signed add slip to the Registrar/Academic Advising Center in Hruby Hall, or forward an email from the professor to registrar@aquinas.edu.
- A kiosk is located in the Registrar/Academic Advising Center for you to use to register, if you choose. We will be happy to walk you through the online registration process during regular business hours.
- You may select your classes prior to the date you are able to register online. The classes will be held for you in the **Register and Drop Sections** page until you are ready to register.

In-Person Registration Instructions:

Students may register by delivering their registration cards to the Registrar/Academic Advising Center (HH30), if preferred.

Continuing Education Students:

CE students may register online, in person, by email, or by telephone. If you choose to register online, please follow the steps listed above. Although you are not required to get electronic permission from your advisor before registering, the Registrar recommends that you meet regularly with your advisor to review your degree plan.

ADDING CLASSES FOR SPRING, 2020

You may add an open class by using MyAQ any time during the add period. If a class is full, an add slip, signed by the instructor, is required. You must deliver the signed add slip to the Registrar/Academic Advising Center by the add deadlines listed here.

Last day to ADD a Third Quad or Semester-long class is Friday, January 17, 2020.

Last day to ADD a Fourth Quad class is Friday, March 20, 2020.

Attendance at the 1st class meeting is required for all 8-week classes.

POLICIES REGARDING DROPS, NO SHOWS, AND WITHDRAWALS FOR SPRING, 2020

Dropped Courses

All students (Regular, CE, Graduate, Guest, Non-Degree, etc.) may drop a class for a full refund by the dates listed above under Financial Drop Dates. Any course dropped after these deadlines will be charged at the full tuition rate. Traditional-age students are considered full-time as of the Financial Drop Date for semester-long classes if registered for 12 or more credits.

No-Show Policy and \$150.00 Fee

Students who do not officially drop a class within the initial add/drop period, and are administratively dropped from a class because of non-attendance, will be assessed a fee of \$150.00 per class. Students who are full-time after the second week of the semester and who are administratively dropped from a course which begins in the second or fourth quadsemester will be financially responsible for full-time charges, even if the administrative drop results in the student being enrolled less than full-time. For students officially dropping a class, either before the class starts or within the add/drop period, there will be no charge. See Financial Drop Dates. **Note: Responsibility for registration, add, and drop rests with the student. Instructors and advisors are not able to make changes to a student's registration and are not responsible for notifying the Registrar's Office of student registration changes.**

Withdrawals

If a student chooses to withdraw from **ALL** of his/her courses because of personal, health, or other reasons, the student must notify the Registrar in writing of his/her intent to withdraw. Students must complete a Withdrawal Form, available in the Registrar/Academic Advising Center. Tuition charges will be incurred according to the date of written notification of the withdrawal. Academic penalties will be incurred for any courses past midterm at time of withdrawal. Title IV funds will be pro-rated for a complete withdrawal. Please see the Financial Aid section of the College Catalog. If a student withdraws from ALL classes and receives financial assistance, the student must contact the Financial Aid Office for an interview to review the refund policy.

SPECIAL PRICING FOR NEW CONTINUING EDUCATION STUDENTS **TAKING THEIR FIRST COURSE IN SPRING, 2020**

New Continuing Education students will receive reduced tuition (50%) for their first three Aquinas College credits. This includes students accepted as CE students who have never taken classes at Aquinas College **OR** previous CE students who have been re-admitted after an Aquinas enrollment gap of at least 2 years.

Payment Plans

The College offers two payment plans:

1. **Five Month Payment Plans (plan cost is \$35.00 per semester)**

Option 1: AQ Agreement-Make payments directly to the Student Accounts office or through MyAQ. You must contact Student Accounts to set up this option.

Option 2: Official Payments-payments will be auto withdrawn each month. Visit www.aquinas.edu/studentaccounts to set up this option.

2. **Employer Tuition Reimbursement Plan**

The Aquinas College Employer Tuition Reimbursement Plan allows students who expect to receive tuition reimbursement from their employers to apply for deferred payment of tuition. A non-refundable charge of \$35.00 per semester is due with application for this plan. The application must be approved by the Student Accounts Office.

Financial Aid

To be considered for any source of financial aid, a student must complete all necessary applications by the appropriate deadlines. Financial aid is credited to a student's direct charges (tuition, and if applicable, room and board) based on the student's enrollment status for that given semester. Full time= 12+ credits; Part-time = 6-11 credits. Financial aid is renewable each academic year, as long as the student completes the necessary application, maintains eligibility, and is making satisfactory academic progress toward a degree. See "Satisfactory Academic Progress" under Financial Aid in the Aquinas College catalog. Students who are on probation for two consecutive full time semesters or the equivalent are no longer eligible to receive financial aid. A student has the right to appeal to the Aquinas College Review Board for Academic Dismissal.

If a student drops a class during the refund period, financial aid will be adjusted. If a student withdraws from all classes and receives financial assistance, the Financial Aid Office must be contacted to discuss the student's rights and responsibilities concerning the college's refund policy.

Students should contact the Financial Aid Office when adding or dropping any classes as it may affect awarded aid and/or loans.

E-Mail Policy: Every Aquinas College student is assigned an Internet e-mail account to access official College business and academic information. ELM Passwords: An ELM password is required to access all Aquinas College applications including e-mail, CourseConnect, MyAQ, and academic specific software. An ELM account will be created for new students on their STAR or Transfer Advising Registration Day. Otherwise, an ELM account will be created once a new student registers for classes and a One-Time Access Key will be mailed to the home address on file with the College. This information can also be picked up in person from the ITS Department, Campus Safety, or the Library with a picture ID. A student ID number is needed to set up an ELM password.

MyAQ: MyAQ is an online resource available for students to view their schedule, advisors' names, grades, financial aid information, and tuition statements. Students may also make online payments, search for classes, and register for undergraduate classes in a given semester. Students must view tuition statements through MyAQ, as paper bills are no longer being mailed. MyAQ can be accessed at aquinas.edu/elm using your ELM password. Guest access is available to search for available course sections.

CourseConnect: Course Connect is a web-based, course-management software application used by many professors for a variety of courses. In web-based, Internet-enhanced courses, students may not meet as a group on a regular basis as they do in other courses. A critical key to success is maintaining on-going communication with the instructor and classmates by email, telephone, or online chatting within CourseConnect. Graduation

Students who intend to graduate in May of 2020, August of 2020, or December of 2020 must complete an Application for Degree, **signed by their major/minor department Chairperson(s)**, and submit it to the Registrar/Academic Advising Center (Hruby Hall 30). This signed application should be submitted at least two semesters prior to the intended graduation date. Students will receive a signed copy of the initial audit in return. A final audit of academic records takes place after the final semester grades are posted. There is one Commencement ceremony per year, in May.

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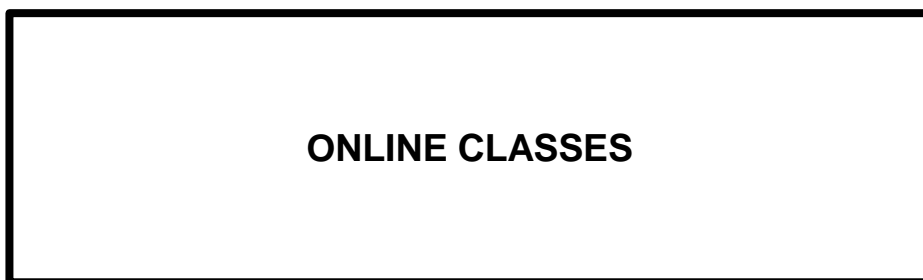
