Participants must be full-time students of at least sophomore status and have completed WL301 with a grade of C or better or its test equivalent. Participants must also be open to the cross-cultural experience and living with Spanish nationals, and be in good academic and disciplinary standing.



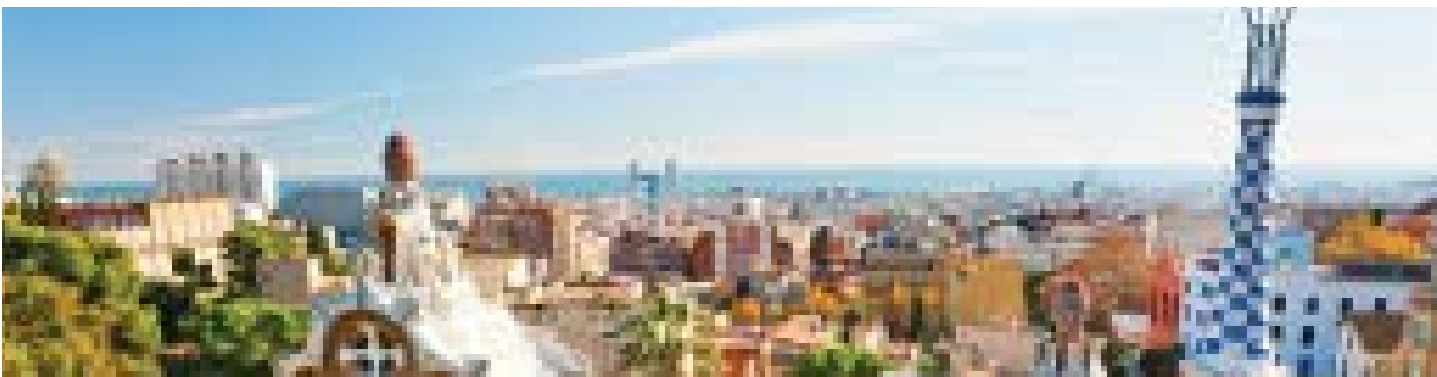
## ACADEMICS
